

Protect the Gnome

ACTIVITY SHEET 008

Objectives: Defensive and offensive strategy

Number of players: 2 vs 2 or 3 vs 3

Equipment:

- Place the figurine on the floor in an area of the field where you want to work with the teams..
- Six (6) balls per team :
 - o 3 balls per player = 2 vs 2
 - o 2 balls per player = 3 vs 3

Set up:

Place the figurine on the floor in an area of the field where you want to work with the teams.



Procedure:

- First, in turn, players from **team #1** throw their balls around the figurine and try to create barriers to protect it.
- Second, after team #1 has thrown all its balls, team #2 tries to destroy the barriers and knock down the figurine. Players from team #2 decide who among themselves will throw the ball.

Note: For this part of the activity, lobbing is prohibited.

- If the figurine falls, team #2 is the winning team. If the figurine remains in place, team #1 wins.
- Repeat the exercise by reversing the roles of the teams.


Safety instructions:

Players cannot throw at the same time.




EXAMPLE

- 1. Place the gnome randomly on the field.
- 2. The defending team throws its balls to protect the gnome.



- 3. The attacking team tries to knock down the gnome.
- 4. If they succeed, they win; otherwise, the defending team wins.



The gnome has been knocked down, so the attacking team wins.
